~ Mr Burns,

To ask the Minister of Justice to detail the number of (i) police officers; and (ii) prison officers who have been disciplined for accepting bribes in each of the last 10 years, broken down by the rank of the officer.

The above mentioned question was placed before the Minister of Justice, who has deemed that this is an operational matter for the Police Service of Northern Ireland. Therefore the Chief Constable has been asked to respond directly.

The Police Service of Northern Ireland can state in reply to Part (i) of the question that no police officers have been disciplined for accepting bribes in the last 10 years.
